## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- **Clinical Experience** — Prefer one year of acute care hospital-based nursing experience in specialties such as critical/intensive care, coronary care, emergency, medical, surgical, operating room, or telemetry
- **Commitment** — Nurses accepted into the program must commit to the program for 36 months and have the desire to pursue an advanced nursing degree.
